

Addition of Tens and Units (1st Class)

Take the sum:

$53 + 28 =$

Step 1:

Write the sum vertically using T U headers as follows:

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{T U} \\ 53 \\ + 28 \\ \hline \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Step 2:

Add the units together and write under the units line as follows:

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{T U} \\ 53 \\ + 28 \\ \hline \\ \hline 11 \end{array}$$

Step 3:

Circle the 10's in the number and put on the T's side. Put remaining units under the units. Add all the 10's together as follows:

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{T U} \\ 53 \\ + \textcircled{1}28 \\ \hline 81 \\ \hline \textcircled{1}1 \end{array}$$
